



AIRLINE AIRCREW TRAINING CENTRE

AIRCREW TRAINING CENTRE

This Familiarisation trip will be to our unique 737 Cabin Trainer which is based at our Aircrew Training Centre at Auckland Airport. The cost of this two day familiarisation is included in your course fees.

While at the Aircrew Training Centre you will participate in the following:

- Preparing the cabin for take off

As the cabin trainer is a complete 737 aircraft you will get to experience what is really involved in boarding passengers, assisting with hand luggage and helping special needs passengers.

- Final duties before departure

The completion of final cabin checks, the safety demonstration using oxygen masks and life vests, and the arming of the aircraft doors gives you the opportunity to put what you have learnt into practice.

- Opening and closing a 737 door

All four doors on the 737 cabin trainer open and close. The correct procedure for arming and disarming doors is a component in any initial flight attendant training programme.

- Emergency equipment location

While on the cabin trainer you will locate a range of emergency equipment such as smokehoods, first aid kits, portable oxygen, life vests, oxygen masks and other pieces of equipment.

- Communication System

This is vital for communication between the crew, and also for making announcements to passengers. The PA system on board the cabin trainer will mean you can experience and practise how to make professional announcements.

- Emergency Evacuation

Experience what it is like to be involved in an emergency evacuation, when flight attendants open the aircraft doors and inflate the slides so passengers can evacuate the aircraft. The mock evacuation will see you go down the slide and experience what would be required in a real emergency.

- Liferaft

The 40 man liferaft located at the Aircrew Training Centre will give you an opportunity to experience what it would be like to have to survive inside a raft, put up the canopy and be confident with the emergency equipment onboard the raft.
